Journey

Journey directions to Bad Kreuznach

The venue is located in Bad Kreuznach. We recommend sticking to your navigation system of choice. Nonetheless, here is a short description of how to get to the venue.

Address: Nahetal-Jugendherberge, Rheingrafenstraße 53, 55543 Bad Kreuznach, Germany

By car:

From Frankfurt (from the northeast/east):

Take motorway **A3** in the direction of Köln / Wiesbaden / Frankfurt Flughafen and change to **A67** in the direction of Darmstadt / Mainz / Rüsselsheim at the Mönchhof Dreieck. After ~ 7 km change to **A60** in the direction of Mainz / Wiesbaden / Rüsselsheim at the Rüsselsheimer Dreieck. Stay on this motorway for ~42 km and then keep left to get onto **A61** in the direction of Ludwigshafen / Bad Kreuznach. After another ~4 km take the exit toward **B41** in the direction of Bad Kreuznach / Idar-Oberstein / Sprendlingen / Langen-Lonsheim. Stay on the **B41** for ~5 km and then take the exit in the direction Bad Kreuznach / Zentrum / Mitte. Follow Gensinger Straße for ~2 km and then stick to the map below.

From Köln (from the north):

Take motorway **A61** in the direction of Koblenz / Trier / Bad Neuenahr-Ahrweiler and stay on it for ~120 km. Then keep left to stay on the A61 in the direction of Ludwigshafen / Bad Kreuznach. After another ~4 km take the exit toward **B41**, in the direction of Bad Kreuznach / Idar-Oberstein / Sprendlingen / Langen-Lonsheim. Stay on the **B41** for ~5 km and then take the exit in the direction Bad Kreuznach / Zentrum / Mitte. Follow Gensinger Straße for ~2 km and then stick to the map below.

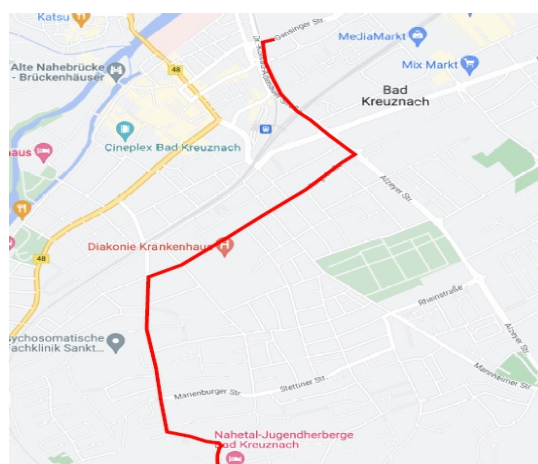
From Mannheim (from the south):

Take motorway **A650** in the direction of Saarbrücken / Kaiserslautern and stay on it for ~7 km. Then change to **A61** in the direction of Koblenz / Mainz / Kaiserslautern and stay on it for ~60 km. Take the exit toward B41, in the direction of Bad Kreuznach / Idar-Oberstein / Sprendlingen / Langen-Lonsheim. Stay on the **B41** for ~5 km and then take the exit in the direction Bad Kreuznach / Zentrum / Mitte. Follow Gensinger Straße for ~2 km and then stick to the map below.

By public transport

There is a train station in Bad Kreuznach. There are many train connections from Frankfurt (Main) Hauptbahnhof and from Köln Hauptbahnhof. Trains from Frankfurt pass through Bad Kreuznach if you take **RE3 (29514)** vlexx in the direction of Saarbrücken. The train also makes a stop at Frankfurt Airport and in Mainz. The journey lasts ~60 min.

If you come by train from the direction of Köln, you can either change trains in Koblenz Hauptbahnhof to **RE17 (29655)** vlexx in the direction of Kaiserslautern, or you can change in Bingen (Rhein) Hauptbahnhof to hop on the above-named or to **RB65 (12716)** in the direction of Kaiserslautern. From the main station in Bad Kreuznach you can easily get to the venue on foot.
